Requirements: In order to be in the Chesterton Academy, you must take Theology, Philosophy, Literature, and History simultaneously because these courses are integrated within each year and over the full 4 years. If a student wants to take a Chesterton Academy class, he/she must take it as an elective in addition to all of the other CCHS requirements.

Spirit of the Law. Although not required, in order to stay within the spirit of the Chesterton Academy and a truly Catholic classical education, you will want to go to daily Mass and take: Latin, Music, Art, Drama (school play).

Other state \& CCHS requirements: 1 Semester Physical Education- satisfied with 2 full seasons of sports play (includes cheerleading and marching band); 1 semester Health; 1 semester Personal Finance/Economics; 2 semesters of fine arts, 4 years of math, and 3 years of science.

College Credit. 1) Franciscan Advantage is a concurrent enrollment program through Franciscan University. The student will gain college credit at a fee of $\$ 300$ for the class. 2) The student will gain college credit for the philosophy courses taken at a fee of $\$ 300$ per class.

Honors Track. The Chesterton Academy is an honors track within Catholic Central High School that challenges the students to write, speak and discuss what they are learning. If you are not interested in an honors curriculum, you should not take the Chesterton Academy classes. Although the classes are challenging, they are not impossible. However, students will need to adjust to the work load.

Commitment. If you take a Chesterton Academy track, you agree to stick with it for 1 year and then make a decision at the end of the year. The exception would be if you fail a class, you drop out within the add/drop period, or the teachers/administration recommend leaving the Academy.
