Our students are off to a great start using their reading skills in the Accelerated Reader program through Renaissance. Beginning this year, students are now permitted to take Accelerated Reader quizzes outside of the school building. Just like the First in Math program, students are able to review what they've learned in the classroom in their own home.

What is Accelerated Reader?

Accelerated Reader is a computer-based program that encourages reading and growth through short quizzes. Some of our teachers use A.R. within their curriculum, while others use it during downtime. Quizzes may be taken on books that your child has read at home, at school, or anywhere!

Logging in to Accelerated Reader from home:

1. Visit:

2. When it asks for the School ID, enter: **BJKMER-18XH**. Once you've used it once, the School ID should be saved on that particular device.
3. Each homeroom teacher has the specific login information for their students and should make them available to you in the coming days.
